Bauxite

Description

Bauxite is a sedimentary rock with a relatively high aluminium content. It is the world's main source of aluminium.

Use

Bauxite is used in a lot of industries like the chemical industry, refractory, abrasive, cement, steel, and petrol industry amongst others. In chemical, bauxite along with alumina is used in the manufacturing of aluminium chemicals. In refractory, it is used as a raw material for making several products Occurrence: Ziarat, Mastung



Zircon
